Meeting Outcomes

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on 12 December 2024 to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007, Liquor Act 2007, Gaming Machines Act 2001,* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976.* The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for 22 January 2025.

Definitions:

Approved – The application has been approved. The approval may be subject to conditions or provision of certain information.
