Meeting Outcomes

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on 19 February 2025 to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007, Liquor Act 2007, Gaming Machines Act 2001,* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976.* The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for 19 March 2025.

An application under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act* 2007 was also considered out of session.

ILGA considered the following matters, and the status of each matter is listed below.
